## **OUR BASIC COURSE**

This program is for those participants who want to become a complete guide – either to procure employment as a guide, or to learn the skills for private boating! We will cover all aspects of guiding a river trip: boats, helmets, technical gear, leadership, group dynamics, crew orientation, river rescue, guest service, interpretation, raft rigging and river navigation.

Our Program emphasizes river-reading techniques, rather than memorization of set routes. This enables our trainees to guide on Class III water anywhere, not just on those sections previously run. We provide a state certified instructor for this guide-training program. Upon completion, all participants will meet the requirements for a Colorado Class III river guide.

## THE COST FOR THIS COURSE IS \$395
